DETAIL

The course proposed is a half day in duration and as well as a classroom based comprehensive briefing on adverse weather driving also covers practical On Road adverse weather training and utilising our Skid Car, Skid cause & prevention training.

On arrival participants will receive tea and coffee and then have the all-important safety & training briefing for the day, this is also an opportunity for the delegates to offer any specific concerns relating to their general driving or any of the course content.

Setting the scene for any training course is of paramount importance and this particular briefing will cover preparation for winter driving, journey planning, suggested equipment to be carried, tyre type & checks and finally 'is the journey necessary.'

As with all Automotional practical training courses, this course includes a pre course Automotional Driver Profile (on-line ADP) and post training, a full course report will be e-mailed directly to the participant and course administrator as required.

This ensures that full H&S Duty of Care responsibilities are covered.

PRACTICAL TRAINING

SKID CAR

The Skid Car is the perfect way to learn the causes of skids and indeed how to avoid them. The Skid Car, unlike the Skid Pan, can replicate a variety of road surfaces from wet through to black ice. All drivers will learn at their own pace under the watchful and experienced eye of our trainers, learning in a fun and safe environment. This is an invaluable life skill for all drivers and provides the knowledge to 'avoid' skids in the future.



ON ROAD – ADVERSE WEATHER

This practical session sees the trainees guided through how a vehicle can be driven safely in snow & icy conditions, but it also highlights to the trainee the limitations & potential hazards of a standard road vehicle in these conditions.

Many drivers approach adverse weather driving by using a 'standard' driving technique, but our fully qualified trainers will introduce a different approach to driving in adverse weather which will give the trainees the skills required by using a different driving style and the vehicle's technology and abilities to drive more confidently and safely in adverse conditions. Recognising the potential for problems and identifying adverse camber and places where ice may be present is half the battle to surviving winter on our roads.
